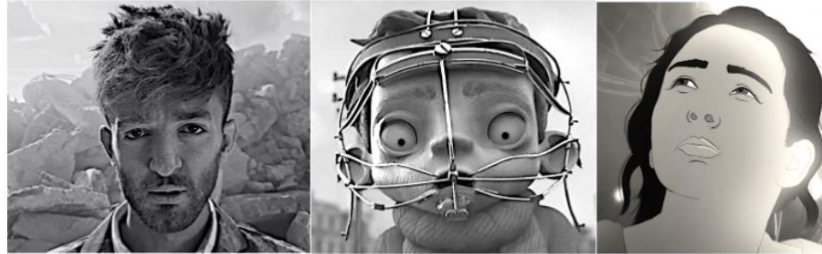


Ten award-winning short films from four continents explore our complicated feelings about climate change & the possibility of inspired response to it.

Drama, documentary, dark comedy, satire, and award-winning animation address our many possible climate futures, exposing a range of interior responses---cynicism and optimism, climate denial and grief, rage and heartbreak, resilience and resolve. Ten films give expression to what we're feeling and offer paths toward climate empowerment. A follow-up half-day climate workshop, online, is offered.

The Festival is produced by [Merlyn Climate Grants](#), a Rhode Island 501(c)3 supporting emerging climate leaders.

- **Bring your community a program of climate films and discussion.**
The two-hour program is FREE, except for a small production/shipping fee, when attendance at your screening is free to the public. A standard screening fee is otherwise charged.
- **Ask your local library, campus, arts center, temple, church, museum or YMCA/JCC to host the Festival.**
- **A half-day online Climate Feeling & Action Workshop**
is offered as follow-up. Discussion starters & thoughtful support materials are available for continued community engagement.
